**Note:** No printed application form will be issued from the college. Both application and admission will be conducted online, the applicants therefore having no need to come to the college premises before the commencement of classes.

**(Candidates can apply in any number of courses with the same registration)**

**No Application fee is needed for online form fill-up** [vide GO Memo no. 706-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14 Dated: 13.07.2021]

- ✚ Candidates must take a print-out (one side of A4 paper) of the application form generated after successful online submission of the form and produce the same **only at the time of physical verification of documents after the classes start.**
- ✚ The candidates have to **upload scanned copies** of passport size colour photograph, Candidate's signature, Madhyamik/equivalent Admit (for Age Proof), H.S. Marksheet, H.S. Registration Certificate and Caste or PWD Certificate (if applicable) during the time of online form fill up.

- ✚ All online admission is provisional and is subject to physical verification of relevant documents during the commencement of classes. The college reserves its right to cancel a candidate's admission if the documents are not found in conformity with the declaration made in the form submitted online.
- Admission will be conducted strictly on the basis of merit.
- Date of publication of provisional and final merit list will be notified on this website.
- After publication of Final Merit List admission will be conducted online and candidates are **NOT** required to report to the college for the process.

### **Eligibility criteria for admission:**

In case of Board/Council other than W.B.C.H.S.E., a candidate shall have to pass in five [four, where applicable] recognized subjects of full marks not being less than 100 out of which one will be English.

Marks obtained in top five subjects shall be considered to ascertain the aggregate marks of a candidate passing the examination under grade system. Also for candidates passing H.S. (10+2) Examination from the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education under old system, marks obtained in top five subjects will be considered to determine the aggregate marks.

Marks obtained in Environmental Studies as a compulsory subject in the H.S. (10+2) Examination conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent will not be taken into account for calculation of the aggregate marks in top five subjects for the purpose of admission.

**Note: Candidates who have already come under CBCS examination system will not be eligible to take admission in this college again.**

### **Eligibility Criteria for Application**

#### **For Honours Degree Courses:**

45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in the subject applied for or related subjects (TABLE-A)\* at the previous qualifying examination.

#### **For General Degree Courses:**

Applicant must qualify the H.S. or equivalent examination.

**The candidates qualifying the vocational courses can apply for general degree courses only.**

No candidate shall be considered for admission after a lapse of 3 (three) years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination or discontinuation of recognized regular courses of study after passing the previous qualifying examination.

## Explanation:

*Applicants, who have passed the H.S. (10+2) Examination in the year 2019/2020/2021 are eligible to apply for Graduate Course in this college this year.*

## Courses Offered:

The college offers 3 year [6 Semesters] Honours and General Degree courses a list of which along with the subject combinations is given below. Following points are to be noted:

For each Honours course two general subjects must have to be taken as subject combination.

For each General course three subjects must have to be taken as subject combination.

A candidate shall be allowed to take up the Honours subject(s) under heading '(X)' if she/he has passed the subject(s) under heading '(Y)' at the previous qualifying examination.

## Merit Point Calculation for Honours Subjects:

### Merit Point= X+Y

X = 10 percent of marks in aggregate in the 10+2 level exam taking 5 best marks among all the subjects excluding the marks of Environmental Studies.

Y= percentage of marks in applied subject as Honours. If that subject is not studied, the percentage of marks of one subject as indicated in the table below will be considered.

Honours Subject	Percentage of marks in applied subject as Honours (Y)

Political Science	Best marks in the language subjects

Note that if more than one candidate score same merit point, preference will be given to higher Y. If more than one candidate have same score in X+Y, preference will be given to higher score in previous examination.

## Merit Point Calculation for B.A. General:

Only aggregate will be considered

## Subject Combination allowed for CBCS System Course:

Course	Elective Subjects
B.A. (General)	Three subjects taking one from any three of the following groups: Group-A: Bengali Group-B: History Group-C: Political Science Group-E: Sanskrit Group-F: English/ Education
B.A. (Honours) Subjects : Bengali, English, Education, History, Political Science	Two subjects (Excluding the subject in which Honours course is taken) from any two of the above groups.

Admission to all Honours/General courses will be strictly on the basis of eligibility criteria and merit.

✓ **Applicants must produce the following documents in original and attach self-attested Xerox copies of the following documents with the printout of the Application Form at the time of Physical Verification during the commencement of classes:**

- ✚ Printed Copy of the Online Application Form with necessary signature.
- ✚ Admit Card of Madhyamik or Equivalent Examination (Document showing the date of birth of the applicant).
- ✚ Marksheet of the Madhyamik or equivalent examination.
- ✚ Registration Certificate of the H.S. or equivalent examination.
- ✚ Mark sheet of the H.S. or equivalent examination.
- ✚ Category (Caste) Certificate. (if applicable)
- ✚ PWD Certificate. (if applicable)
- ✚ School Leaving Certificate.
- ✚ Transfer certificate and University permission/Migration certificate in case the applicant already admitted to another college.
- ✚ Two copies of stamp size colour photograph to be affixed to the printout of the online form.
- ✚ Copy of Bank Challan. [ORIGINAL CHALLAN/RECEIPT OF ONLINE ADMISSION FEES PAYMENT].

After getting admission if a candidate wishes to discontinue his/her studies or wants to strike out his/her name from this college, no money will be refunded.

Eligibility to appear in V.U. Examinations is subject to attendance in college as per V.U. norms.

Attendance in a subject/group of subjects shall be counted from the date of commencement of classes or admission to the course whichever is later.

**N.B: If any kind of error is found in the application form or the candidate is unable to produce the relevant documents (like Caste Certificate, Mark sheet etc.) during the time of Physical Verification, the application of the candidate will be cancelled.**

**IMPORTANT:**

In case of any transaction failure during Admission due to technical or other reasons, the candidates are advised to make a second transaction to secure their candidature. This is a time-bound procedure and their candidature may be lost if the failed transaction is not realized later. They are further advised to inform the college through e-mail (with supportive document) of any such transaction failure within 10 days of the transaction.
